Position Objective:

Reporting:

Primary Duties & Responsibilities:

- Work with Dryer Team on Preseason Maintenance seasonally.
- Work on learning dryer maintenance and repair – troubleshoot malfunctioning dryers.
- Perform general repairs to grain handling systems, dryers, feed mills, grain storage facilities including high places on facilities on site.
- Assist in installation of a wide range of equipment in feed mills and grain handling systems.
- General Labor duties around construction sites and in shop.
- Work site and shop clean up duties.
- Safely Operate equipment at work sites and in shop
- Additional projects and duties required or directed by the K&S General Manager.
- Perform weekend and/or after-hours emergency repairs when needed.

Minimum Requirements:

- Ability to write legibly.
- Good working knowledge of common tools and their use.
- Display pleasant attitude towards customers and co-workers.

- Ability to be on job 40 and up to 50 hours per week. Monday to Friday.
- Work in team setting
- Ability to perform emergency repairs after hours and weekends.
- Ability to safely work at heights installing and maintaining grain and feed equipment.
- Must not have allergies to grain dust and related products that can't be managed.
- Must have flexibility to work on remote projects over night.
